**Are you registered to vote?** If the answer is no, use NETWORK's voter registration and reminder tool! This tool is easy to use and web-based. Even if you are already registered to vote, our tool can send you text or email alerts reminding you to vote leading up to the election. You can also get absentee ballot request forms through the tool!

Once you are registered to vote, we encourage you to take the “I AM A VOTER” pledge to not just vote but **to be a voter**. Voting is habit we form, and the best way to start that habit is to own our identities as **voters**. Take the pledge online or order paper pledge cards at [www.networklobby.org/vote](http://www.networklobby.org/vote). Most importantly, send in your absentee ballot or go to the polls by November 4!

As November approaches, talk about voting with friends and family. Encourage them to take the “I AM A VOTER” pledge with you this fall. Take someone to the polls with you on Election Day, go to vote together. If you have someone in your life who is not yet able to vote due to age or citizenship status, take them to the polls with you to share with them about how voting works and why being a **voter** is important to you.
